## General

### Attire:

- Please ensure that **field uniform** is used at all times **with scarf**

### Attendance:

- Be on time a register will be taken at each session. Sign in with your name and class

### Preparation and Behaviour during sessions:

- Full attention, take notes during your lesson, the aim is as far as possible to complete your worksheet, you will be asked to show this and the end of each session.

### Location:

- **Choose as far as possible a clear background** or blur your background. Backgrounds will be provided however if your computer is unable to cope with this you will be asked to remove the background. The interactive nature of the sessions mean **you must be seen at all times**.
- **YOU MUST have your cameras on!** We will not be telling people over and over to put their cameras on. If you have to be spoken to about this by monitors, where permission has not been requested on the third request you will be asked to leave the session and will be marked as not attended.
- Unless your bedroom has a desk in it and you are **seated at the desk for your sessions** please find a more suitable location, we do not expect pathfinders to be lying in their beds, this is not a listening session it is interactive.

Observe an amphibian to find out:

- i. where and when it sleeps.

- iv. how far it can jump, and as many other interesting things as you can find out about it

## Travel Honour

Please complete the following requirements ahead of the camp.

**6. Create a simple 7-day trip plan for a “family vacation.” As part of your plan, create a 7-day trip planner and include:**

- a. Details on one historic place to visit
- b. Details on two natural sites to visit
- c. Details on one recreational site to visit

Note: the first and last days may be travel days

**8. Calculate approximately how long it would take to walk between Jerusalem and Damascus.**

**9. Sketch a map of a trip mentioned in the Bible:**

- a. Show name of person(s) and path taken including notable stops made.
- b. Show different types of lines for each different mode of transport taken.
- c. Show a “legend/key” for identifying markings and transport types.

Note: You may have to logically guess some aspects of the information if not mentioned directly in scripture
