3. Picture using egg shells

Resources:

- Paper
- Food Colouring
- PVA Glue
- Water
- Black Pen

Instructions:

Food colouring mixture:

1. Drop 3 drops of food colouring (blue, red, yellow) into a bowl
2. Mix with 3 drops of water

Egg shells:

1. Thoroughly clean the egg shells
2. Crunch egg shells with the back of a spoon

3. Then put some eggshells in each of the food colouring mixture bowls
4. Mix around egg shells, so they start to change colour (let these sit for a while)
5. When all egg shells have dried, take them out and let them dry on old paper towels/ kitchen rolls

Design:

1. Draw a shape or a pattern onto a paper with a black pen
2. Then spread a layer of glue onto where you want to stick your egg shells
3. Carefully, stick the egg shells
